

Fox Trap instructions

STEP 1



Your Fox trap will arrive already flat packed (folded) which will be tied together by metal wire. Simply un-tie the metal wire to release the trap.

STEP 2



Whilst unfolding the trap ensure the metal plate in the middle of the trap is on the floor. This is the plate which will trigger the trap door.
Clip the rear door into the metal clips on either side of the trap.

STEP 3



At the front and the middle of the trap there is a support bar which will stop the cage from folding. Fold the bar and tuck it under the base of the trap

STEP 4



Attach the door on the 7th metal runner. The trap door should end so it is inside the cage as shown in the image to the left. Use the ring clips provided to clamp the door to the roof of the trap. Once fastened, the door will automatically be set in the trapped position. To arm the trap door, pull the door upwards towards the roof of the trap. There is a middle anti push bar which stops the door from being pushed open when the pest is trapped. Ensure you push the middle bar down so you can raise the door.

STEP 5



Supplied with the fox trap is a long metal rod with 2 hooks as shown in the photo, the U bend hook in the right photo hooks through the metal plate inside the trap, the hook to the left hooks onto the spring clip as shown in the below picture. The rod hooks onto the u bend spring clip whilst the L shape metal hook goes onto the door whilst in the cocked position.



When the trap is set correctly the rod will raise the metal plate by 1.5cm.
Put some bait just past the plate so the pest goes past the plate. The fox will then be trapped in the cage without harm.
There are 2 handles at the top of the cage so you can carry the pest without contact.
