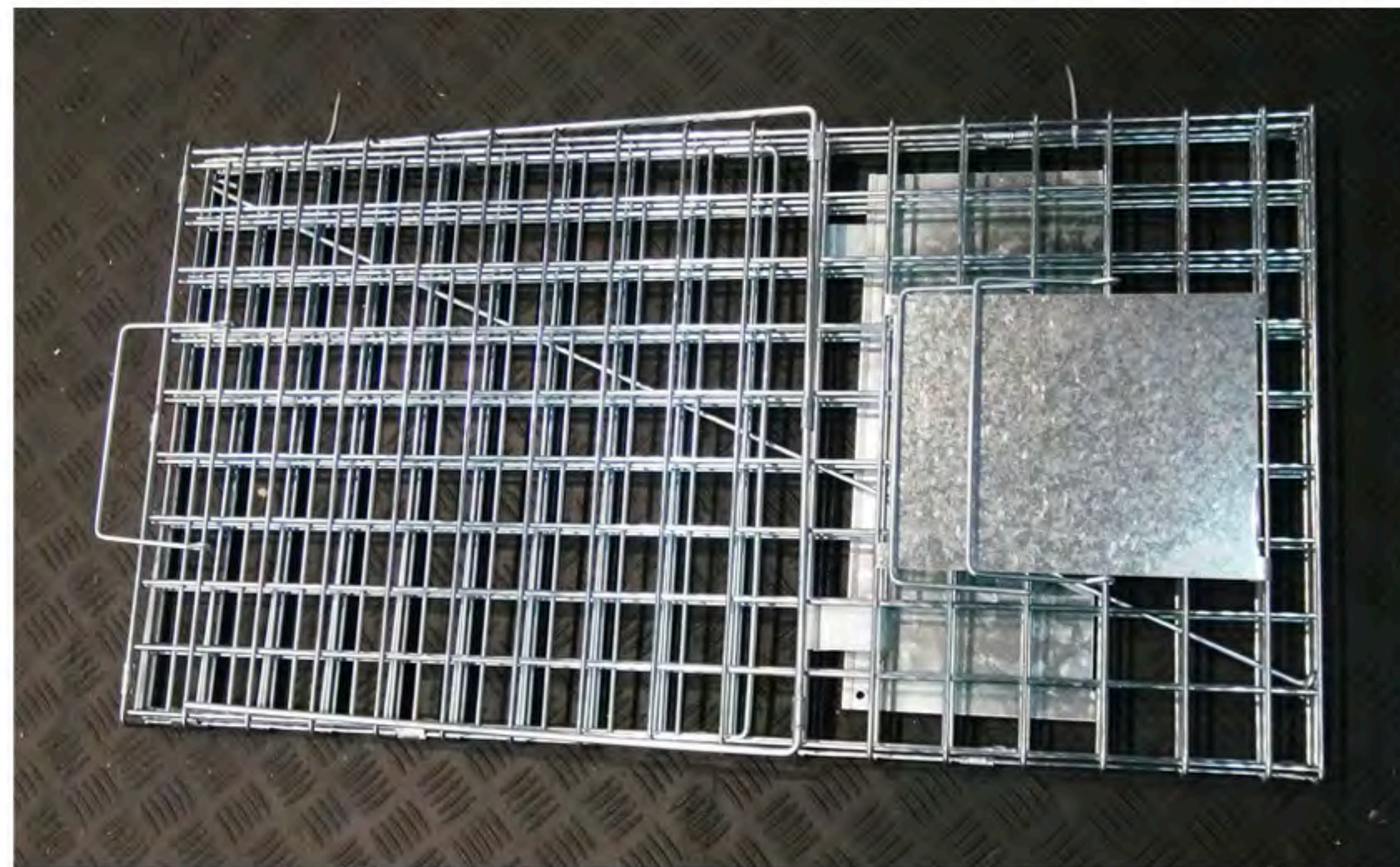


# Fox trap assembly Instructions



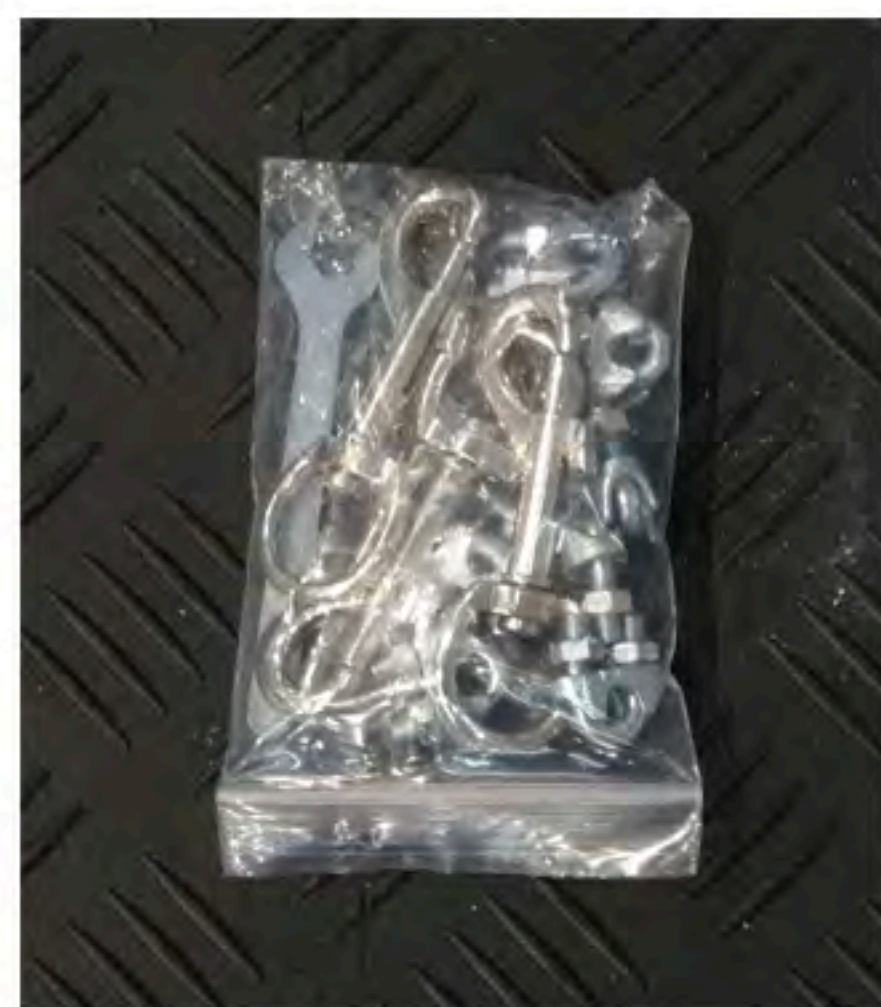
Boxed unit



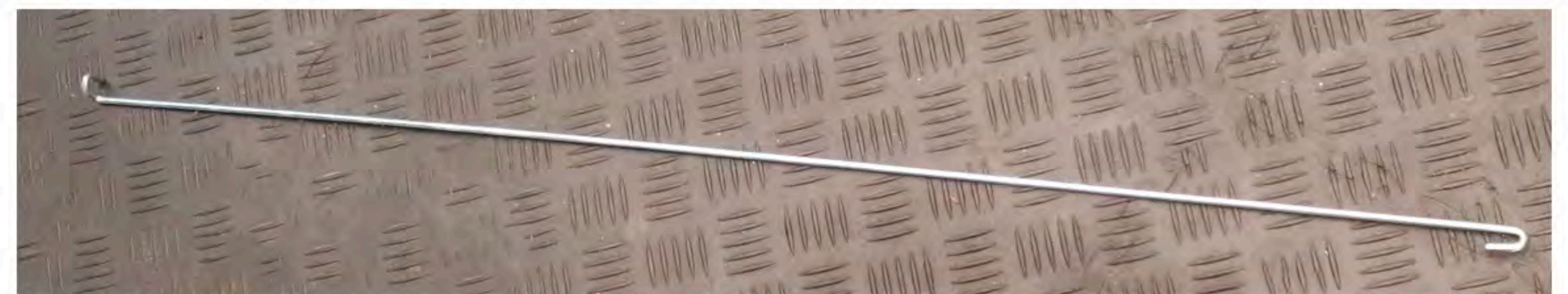
Rear frame

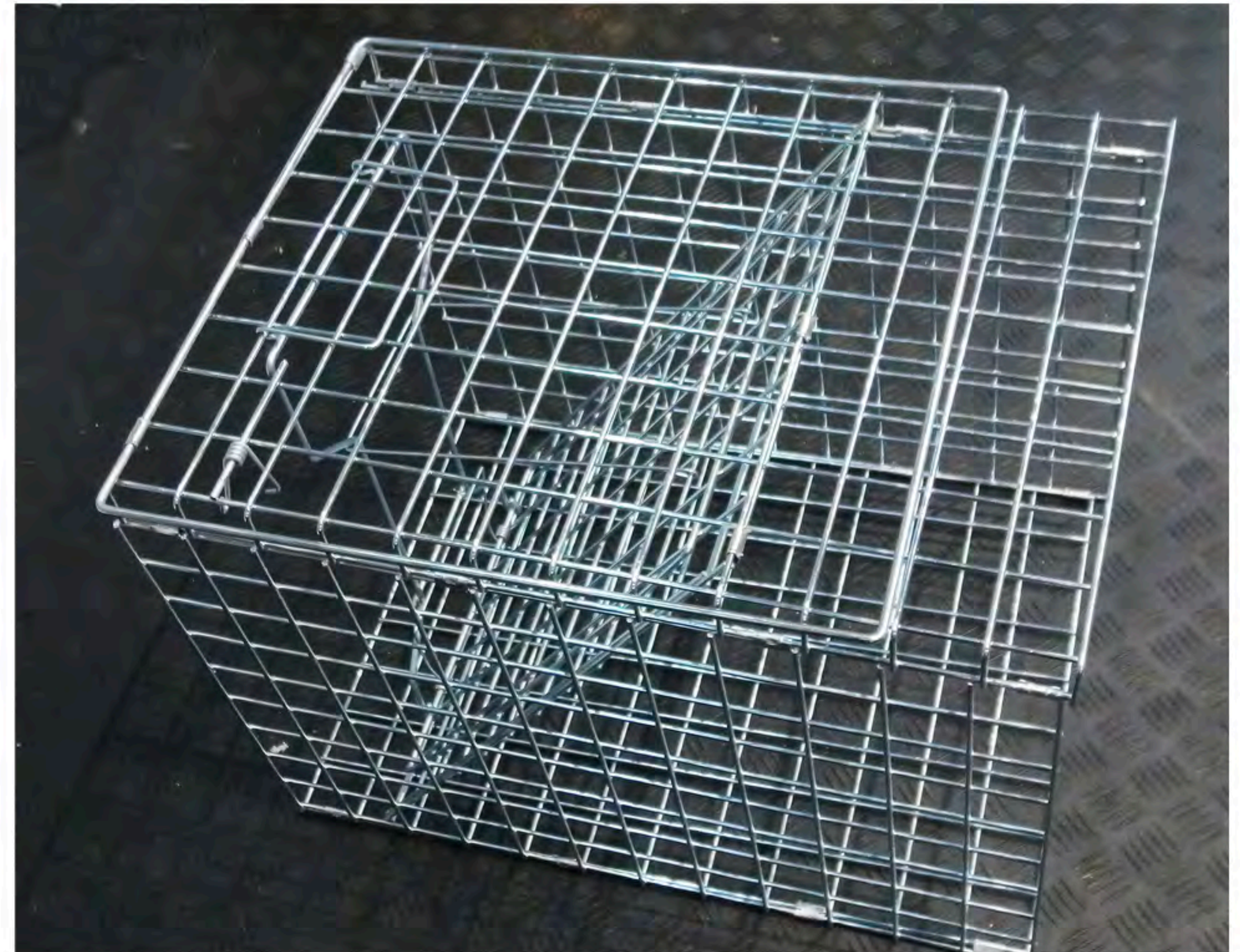

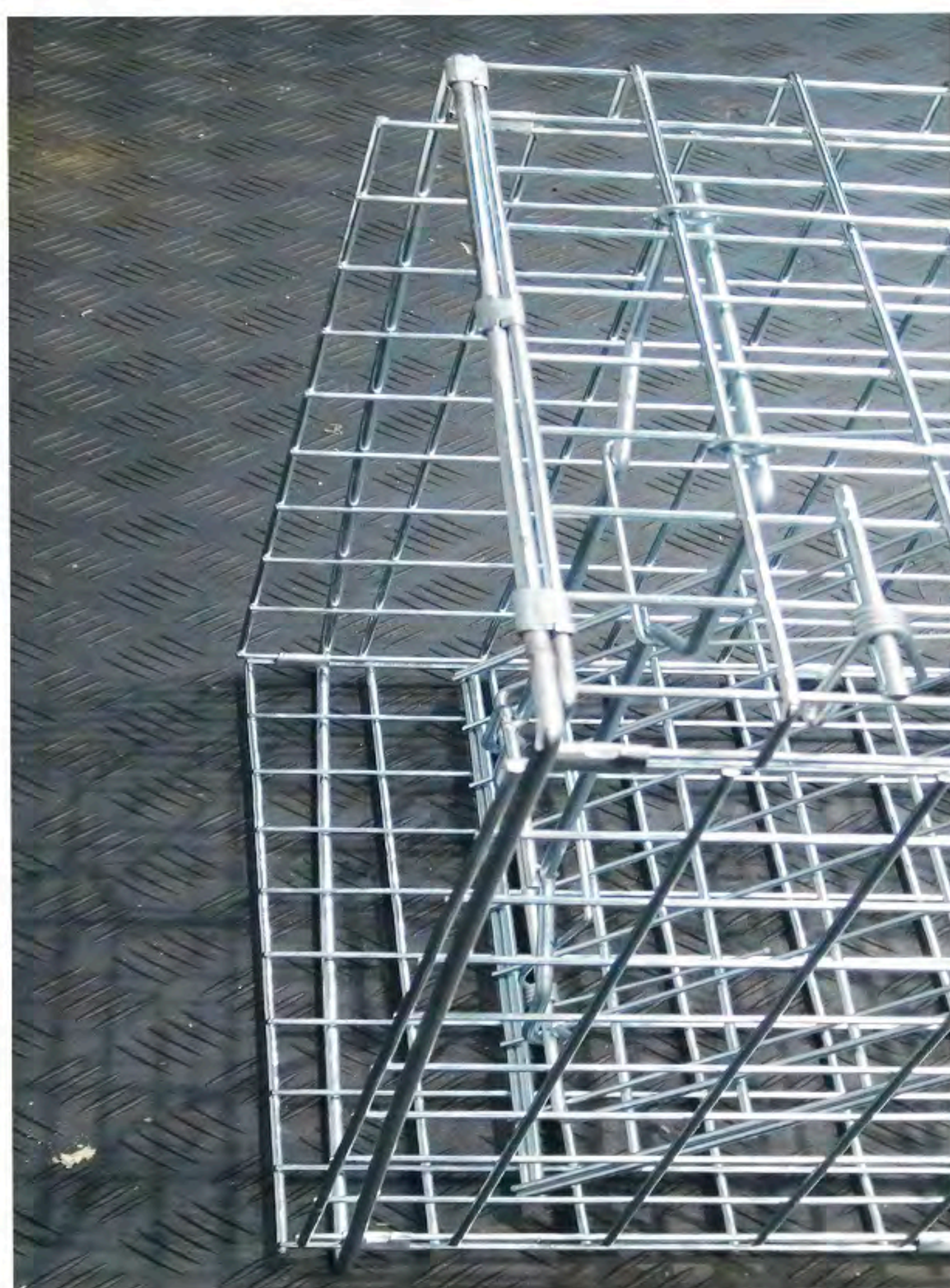
## Step 1

### Front frame assembly

Remove the white cable ties and unfold the cage into a square



Fold the Anti fold support frame under the bottom of the cage. This will stop the trap from folding.





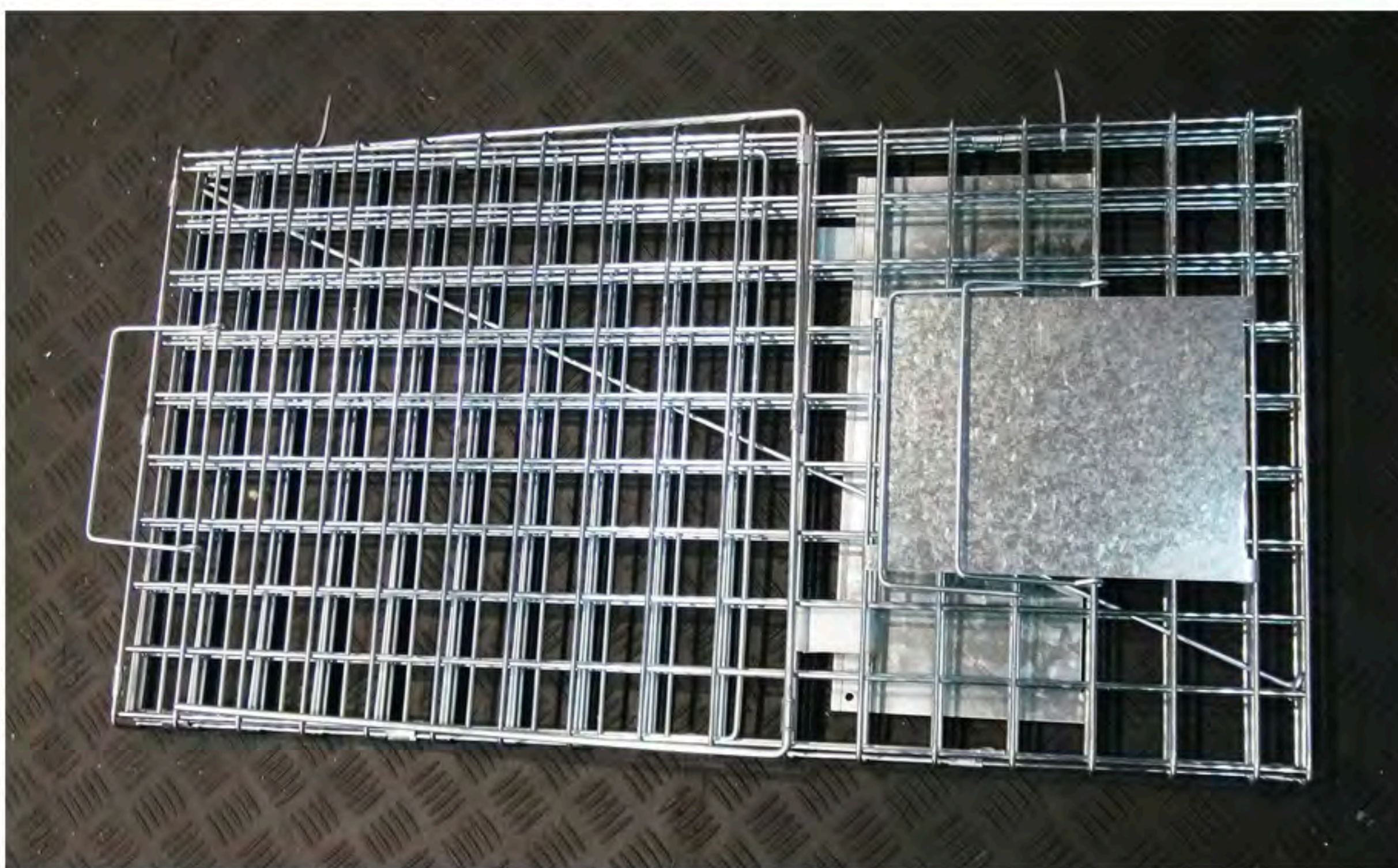
## Step 2

### Rear frame assembly

Cut the cable ties and unfold the cage. Whilst unfolding, remove the trigger rod located in image 2

The rear door will fold down and there will be 1 x support bar to secure into the clips located on the side

Anti fold support clips here



Use the 4 x trigger clips to secure the rear door closed.

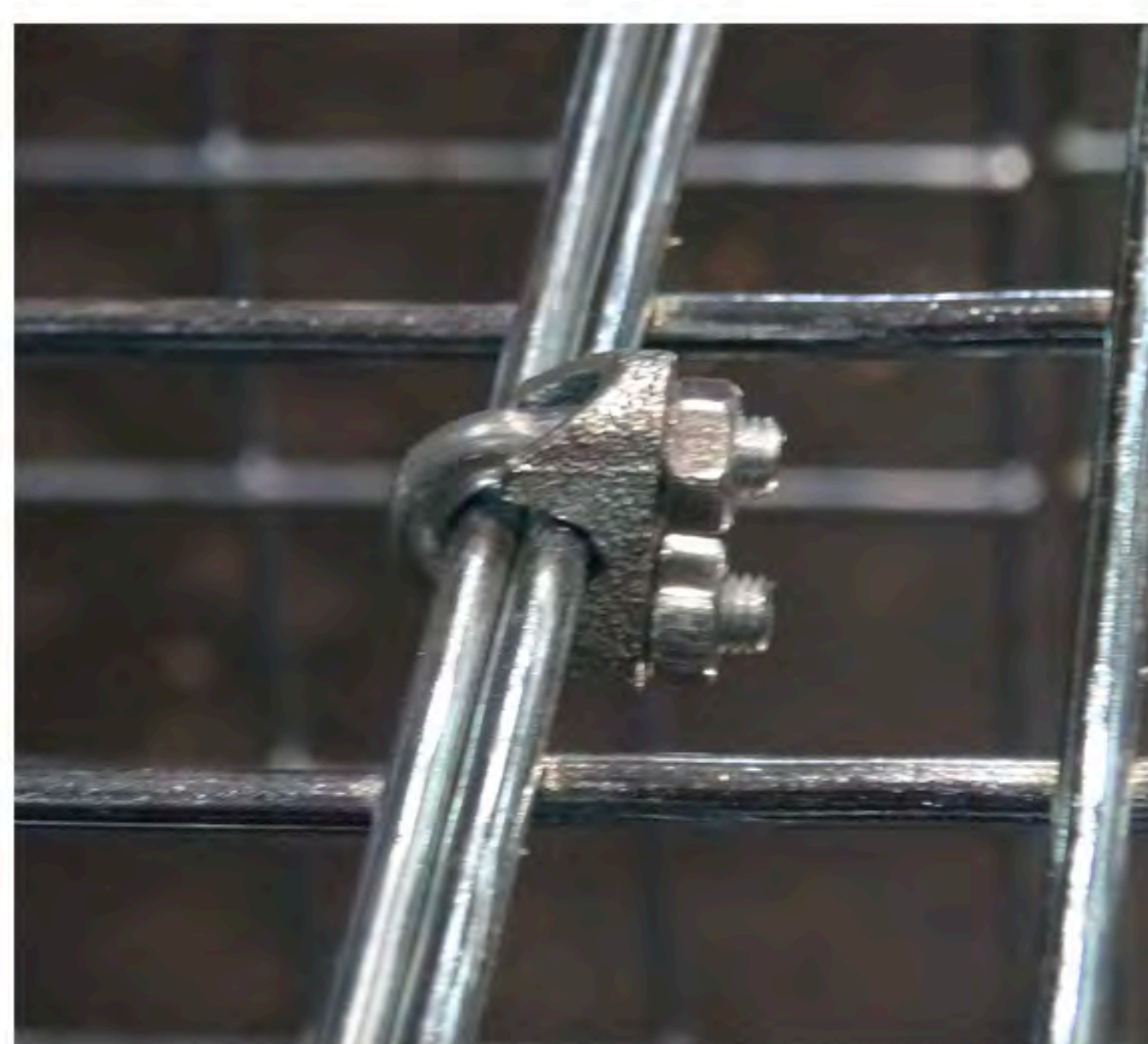
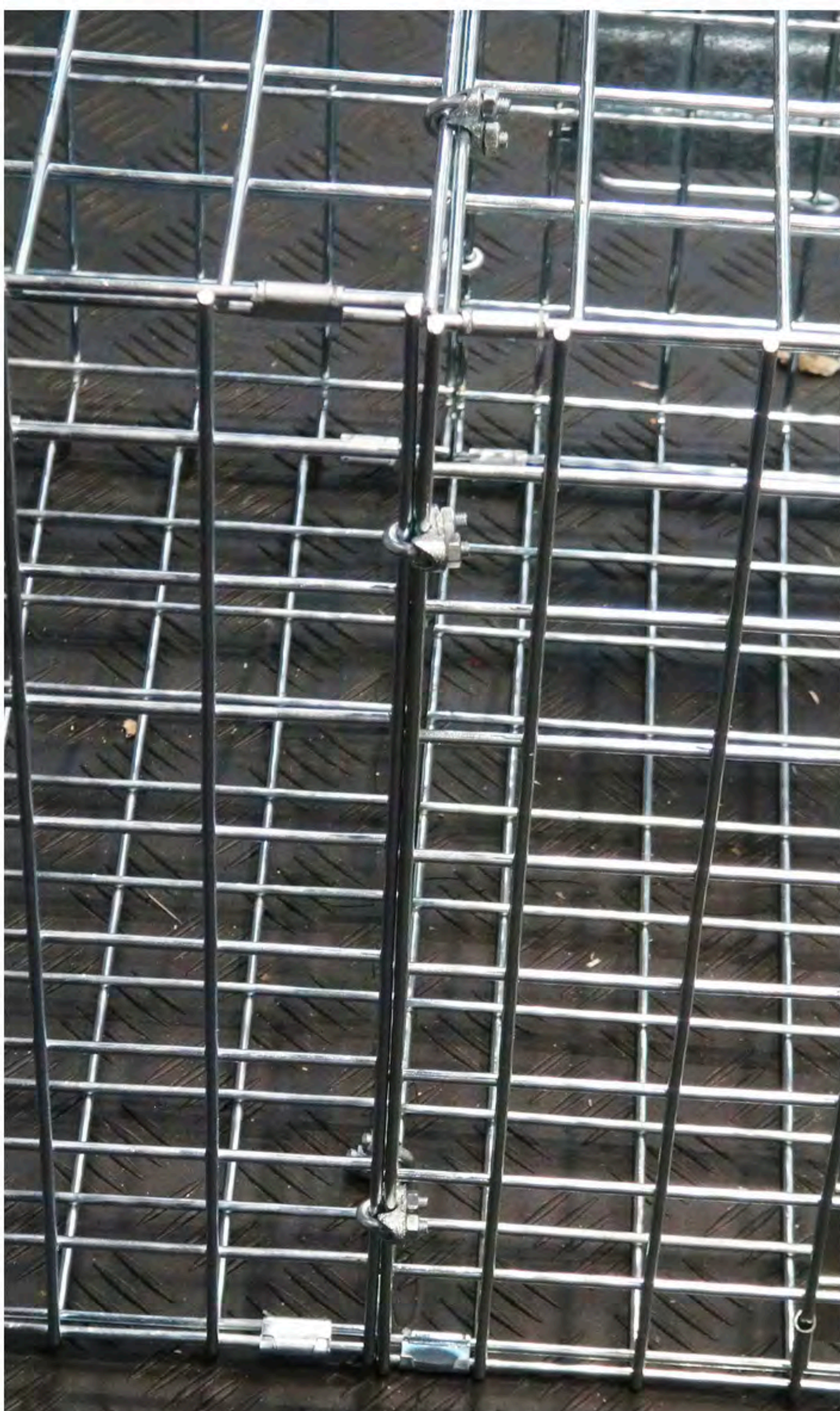
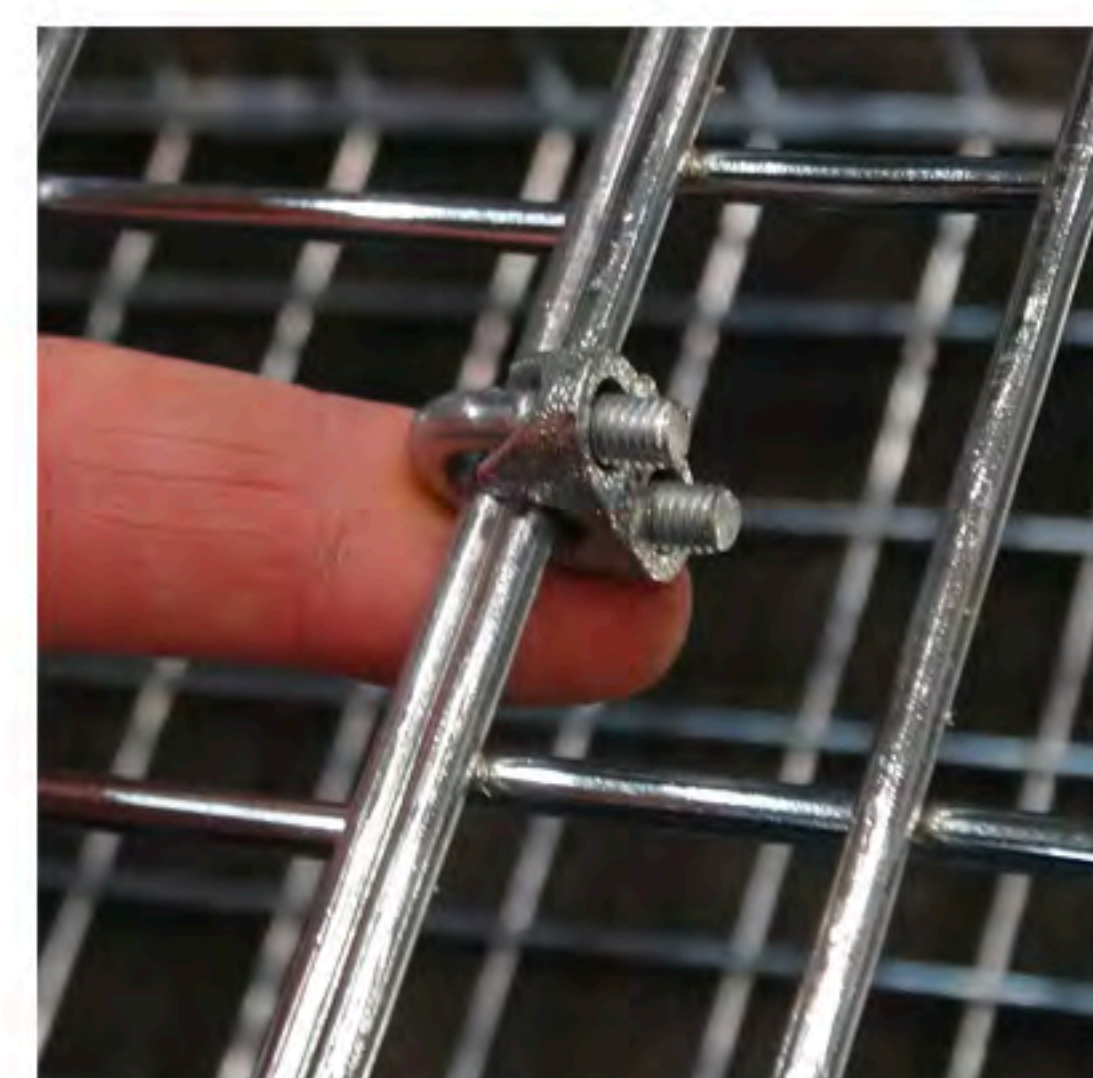
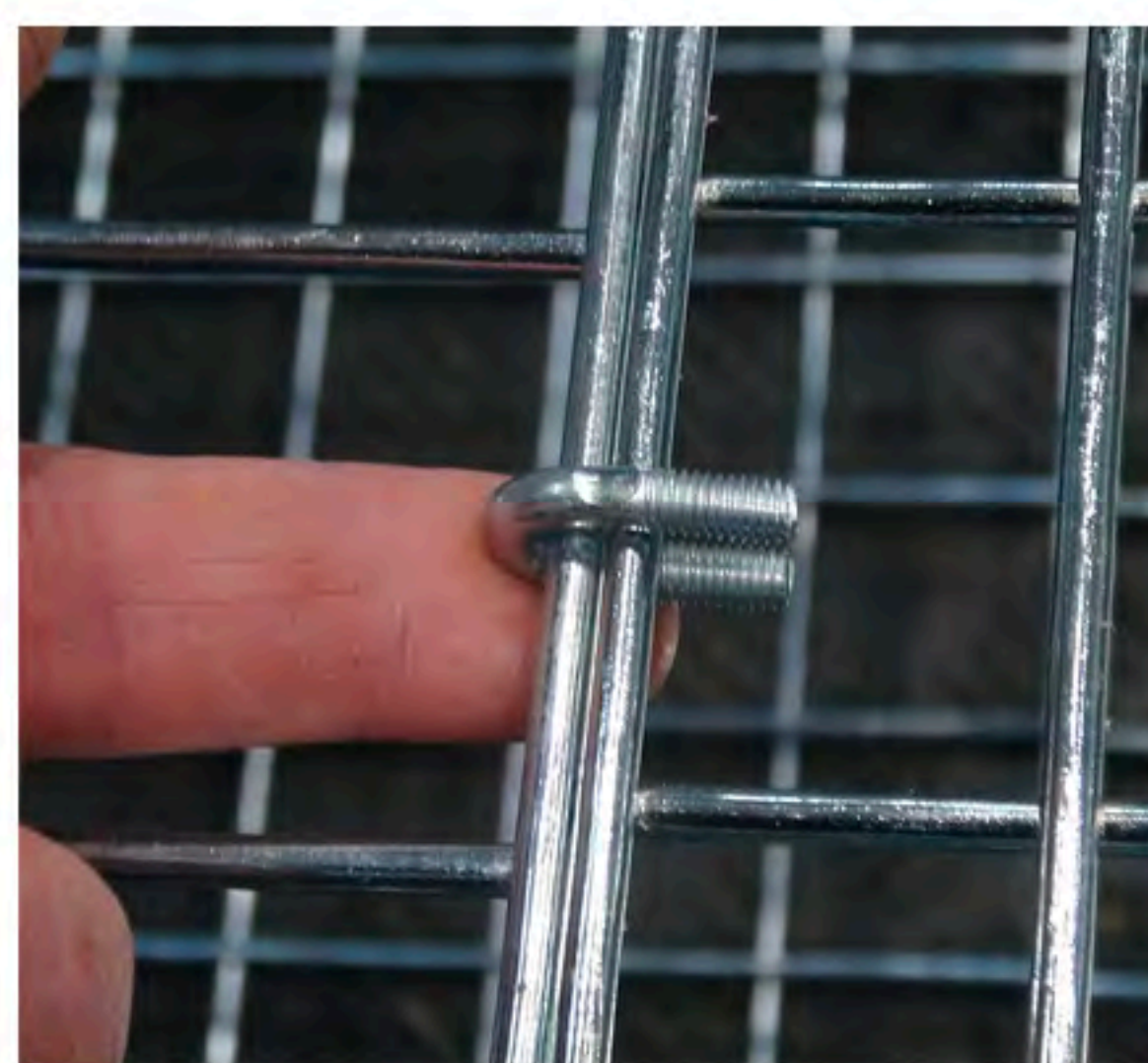
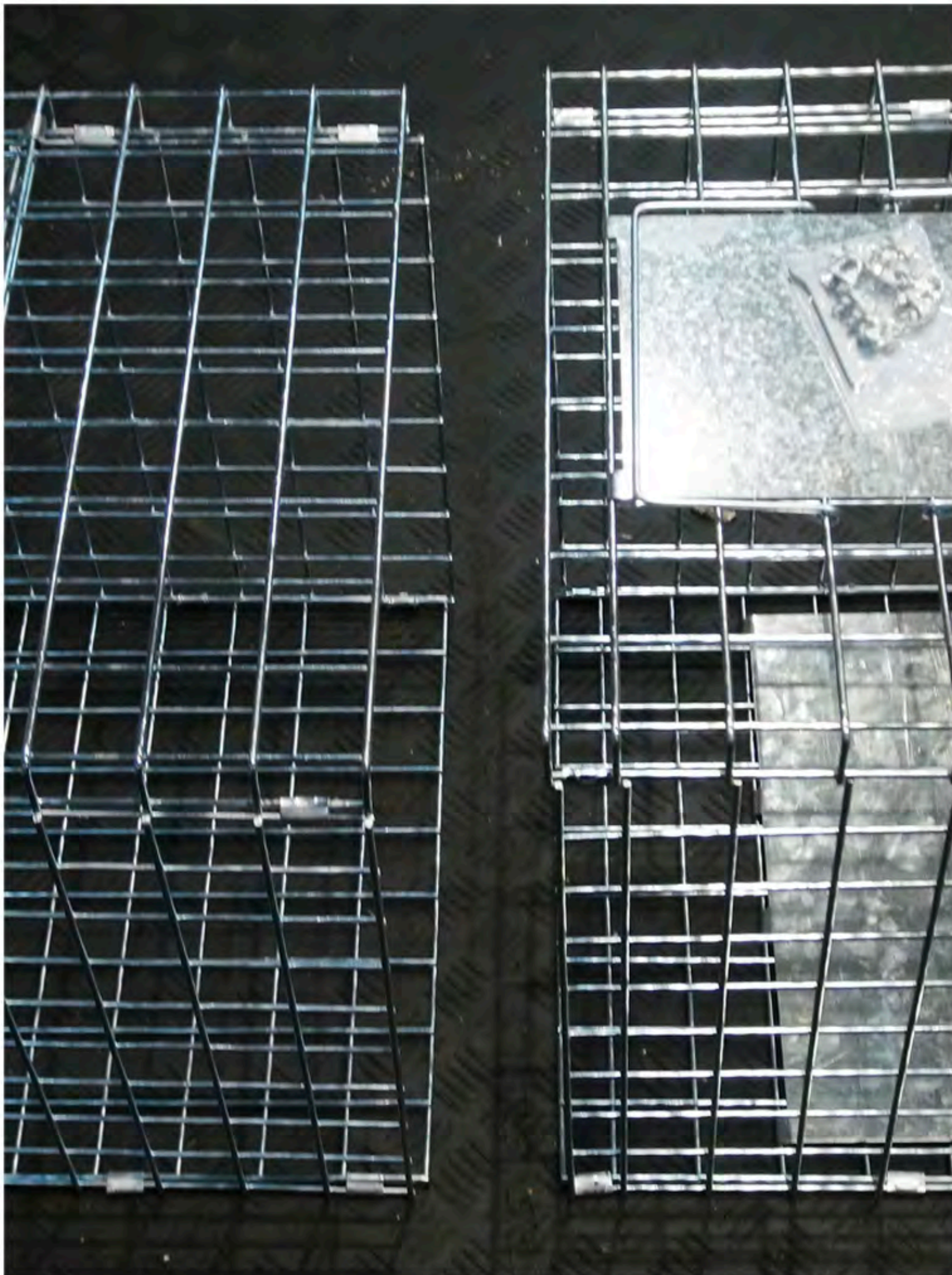




### Step 3

Attach the 2 x frames together using the 8 x clamp nuts and bolts. We do not recommend attaching them on grass incase you lose the nuts.

Place the clamps on the second square from the top and bottom.



Do not tighten with the spanner until all clamp bolts have been fitted hand tight, then tighten with the spanner

Hover the rod with the U shaped hook above the tread plate

Hook from underneath the plate and twist the rod so the U hook connects to the tread plate

The rod position should like like the image above

4



Raise the trap door to the roof of the cage.

Connect the double sided spring hooks like the above image

Your trap is in the armed / ready to trap position  
You can test the trap by pushing the treadplate manually.
